The Spiritual Principle a Day Project has been posted to www.na.org/spad. It has taken a lot of hard work with the staff furloughs and the inability to meet in person for more than a year, but the approval draft is still targeted for the 2022 Conference Agenda Report.

Hello Family,

Good to be here in person today. The Central Ohio Area serves: Franklin, Delaware, Madison and Union counties

- We currently have a total of 52 groups and 74 meetings per week (53 of which are In Person, 15 are Virtual and 6 are Hybrid) Over the last quarter 3 new group and 3 new meetings have been started in our area.
- Vacant area trusted servant positions: Vice-Chair, RCMA, Vice-Treasurer, Vice-Secretary, Activities Chair, H&I,
 Outreach, and Unity Day. We have nominations for H&I & Writing Steps for Recovery scheduled to be voted in
 July.
- I have not had an opportunity to connect with our treasurer, so I don't have current donation information available.

<u>Area Convention</u>: The May report listed 52 basic and 112 full registrations already sold. 36 of 190 rooms booked. COACNA 29 will be held at the Marriott by the Airport on January 14 - 16, 2022. Room rate is \$92/night and there is a website www.COACNA29.org (merchandise is available for purchase)

<u>Area Office:</u> Office was open 2 days a week, Sat 10-1 and Tues 6-8 and are looking for volunteers. In May. they reported 141 phone calls and 3 newcomer calls.

<u>H&I Subcommittee</u>: In May H&I reported 23 active commitments being filled. The held an auction/fundraiser which they raised 1,398. Proceeds of the fundraiser goes toward beefing up our H&I literature inventory. In talks with several facilities regarding starting to transition back to in person meetings. Weekly FCCC both men's and women's meeting has started back in person

Hello ORSCNA family,

All positions on the Fall Retreat committee have been filled. We have several first time committee members which is good to get some new blood on the committee. Both our Programming committee chairs are new to serving on the Retreat, but both have over 35 years clean so I think we will get some excellent speakers and workshop speakers.

We had our first subcommittee meeting on 4/25 at my house. We had our second meeting on 6/12 at the MOASCNA campout up near Howard, OH. Both meetings we very well and we are making good progress. Our third meeting will be 7/24 at noon in Columbus at April and Chris's house – April is the Secretary and Chris is the Hugger Chair. Our last meeting is scheduled for 9/11 at noon, but we haven't decided where to meet yet.

I mentioned in my report in April that we were required to submit a Covid Plan to the ODNR. We created a plan and submitted that to Kim Hillman – our contact at ODNR. Before our plan could be reviewed and accepted, the State of Ohio and the ODNR decided to remove ALL restrictions for the groups renting the resident camp at Tar Hollow. So, hopefully things will continue to go well and we will be as close to normal as possible during this year's Fall Retreat. We certainly still welcome anyone who wants to take their own precautions like masks or distancing. We are planning on getting green, yellow and red wristbands for everyone who registers. Those who would still like to stay distanced could take a yellow wristband while those who aren't yet comfortable with hugs or other contact could take a red wristband. All others would get the green wristbands. There will be signs to explain to everyone the meaning of the wristbands. We are hoping this would help alleviate the awkwardness for those who still have concerns.

Kim Hillman mailed me the contract and I signed that and returned it. We also sent in a deposit of \$558.53. So we are officially booked for the weekend of 10/8 to 10/10.

The flyer is up on the naohio.org website as well as the registration website. We are not doing paper flyers this year because of the cost and the fact that so many meetings are still just online. But you can download the flyer from the website and print out copies for your meetings if you want. Please register online or send in your registration. Also, please announce it at meetings. Our projected budget is currently going to be between \$11,100 and \$17,300. Looking at some previous years expenditures, the average over the last 10 years or so is about \$16,000. One of the concerns this year is food cost. Prices for most items especially meat have gone up a lot recently. Dave our Kitchen Chair is going to do his best to balance between quality food and reasonable prices.

We have taken 42 registrations so far if my counting is accurate. This seems to be higher than normal which is awesome to see. The RV spots have all been reserved. The current bank account balance is \$3,056.79.

Kirby opened the discussion about how hybrid meeting creates a sense of confusion and stated there should be an ad hoc committee or IT person that could curb the confusion such as bad connections and conversations with these hybrid meetings.

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Lynnette CD shared that the Central Ohio Area is looking to perhaps purchase equipment to continue hybrid. Since a lot of people are not able to come back to meetings right now for whatever reason it is best to make accessible to everyone. Therefore, one person is charged to research equipment feasibility and cost that these hybrid meetings can continue. The equipment purchase may be possible due to donations being held. Also, more concerned members will possibly be encouraged to get involved through hybrid meetings. Lastly, getting trusted servants continue to be an issue; however, Central Ohio Area has adapted quite well, meetings have been created out of the pandemic and plan to continue.

Angel - MEASCNA area are experiencing good numbers for meetings with a lot of newcomers in attendance However, the area is struggling getting into facilities but the word out and every position is currently full.

Mattie reiterated the MEASCNA area meetings are almost in full bloom. Members from treatment facilities are showing up by the van full. Virtual meetings have shut down due to opening of in person meetings. Events are heavily participated, and the area is a real tight nit group. Lastly, I will still be working on H&I.

Matthew says this (hybrid) is not a functioning way and asked why are we still doing hybrid; and will it continue? The area is still suffering due to covid in Sandusky bey.

Christian says hybrid meeting has its ups and downs. For instance, everyone does not know how to communicate on computer or tablet. However, some people are partial to hybrid meetings because can be a money saver. Overall, things have been going smoothly.

David C states his area is up and moving again. with only one meeting still online. The FRASCNA – Five Rivers Area will be hosting next quarter's RSC and stated since costs are going up they can't find venue under \$200 which is what policy says the hosting area will be reimbursed.

Dave L says his homegroup donate to area, region, and world. And says he is personally opposed to making donations through pay pal because they assess a service fee.

Hello Family I'm TJ and I am an addict:

I'm grateful to be clean and of service to the Ohio Region. We began our quarterly business meeting with \$6,169.66 in the bank. Business on Saturday produced donations of \$3,507.92. In addition, we paid expenses totaling \$1,213.97. This left us with an ending balance of \$8,463.61 prior to the World Services and MZF donations. Policy dictates we donate 10% of the end of Saturday balance to World Services and 5% to the MZF. Those donations were \$846.36 to NAWS and \$423.18 to MZF. Our final balance at the end of the day on Saturday was \$7,194.07.

Sunday began with a balance of \$7,194.07. Expenses for Sunday totaled \$2470.36. This left us with an ending balance of \$4,723.21 at the end of business of Sunday. The weekend change in the balance of our account was a negative \$1445.95 as indicated on the enclosed income/expense statement.

We returned the OCNA 38 funds of \$7,876.56 we were holding for the OCNA 38 committee. A committee was formed and a bank account was created so this money could be held by the OCNA 38 committee. The amount returned represents the amount we were holding (\$8,376.56) less the \$500.00 loan made to OCNA 38 when the committee was originally formed.
