After our last RSC, Marvin and I attended the 2nd half of the virtual WSC a historical event, the 1st part of the WSC 2020 began on 24 April and officially adjourned on 13 August, when the summary of decisions was posted on na.org. It was the first virtual WSC, and it was also the longest amount of time between beginning and ending a WSC—sixteen weeks! We reported on Part One in the June *NAWS News* update.

Part two of the Conference took place 7–9 August. WSC 2020 decisions included:

- To seat Minas (Brazil) and Northwest Russia as Conference participants. Welcome!
- To consider zonal seating requests only from zones that were formed before WSC 2018, until seating criteria or a process for seating can be established.
- To continue the suspension of the *Fellowship Intellectual Property Trust (FIPT)* Inspection Clause.
- And unanimous approval of the pamphlet *Mental Health in Recovery*. NA's newest piece of recovery literature, IP #30, is posted online at www.na.org/ips and available for sale as inventory item #3130 for 33 cents each at www.na.org/webstore. *Mental Health in Recovery* "reflects the shared experiences of NA members, including those who have found it necessary to seek outside help for mental health concerns and other members who are recovering alongside them." The pamphlet includes sections titled Seeking Professional Help, Medication and Mental Health, Stigma and Shame, Recovery Happens in NA, and Supporting Each Other.

NA Funds, the World Board expenses still exceed income. The World Board and Spiritual Principle a Day Workgroups continue to meet virtually,

This is the second cycle for the Spiritual Principle a Day Project, and we are on track to include the approval draft for the book in the 2022 Conference Agenda Report.

We've posted a sneak preview at the fourth batch of entries for review and input: www.na.org/spad along as do bodies such as the European Delegates Meeting and Canadian Assembly, to which we would have traveled, under ordinary circumstances. October 2020

Hello Family I'm TJ and I am an addict:

I'm grateful to be clean and of service to the Ohio Region. We began our quarterly business meeting with \$12,508.20 in the bank. Business on Saturday produced donations of \$1,465.69. In addition, we paid expenses totaling \$1,410.06. This left us with an ending balance of \$12,563.83 prior to the World Services and MZF donations. Policy dictates we donate 10% of the end of Saturday balance to World Services and 5% to the MZF. Those donations were \$1,256.38 to NAWS and \$628.19 to MZF. Our final balance at the end of the day on Saturday was \$10,679.26.

Sunday began with a balance of \$10,679.26. Expenses for Sunday totaled \$309.78. This left us with an ending balance of \$10,369.48 at the end of business of Sunday. The weekend change in the balance of our account was a negative **\$2,138.72** as indicated on the enclosed income/expense statement.

There are two unusual issues with this report of note. First, we have received deposits totaling \$6,093.00 which are actually funds due to the next OCNA Committee. As such, you will now find a balance sheet which shows total assets and a new liability named OCNA Funds Payable. These funds were not used in the calculation for Saturday donations to NAWS and MZF. These funds will show as a liability until an OCNA committee is formulated and will then be turned over to the committee.

The second unusual issue surrounds payments made to Townhall II and MCI. Last quarter the treasurer at the time, Sam G, accidentally mailed the Townhall II check to MCI and the MCI check to Townhall II. Both companies deposited those checks and they were cleared by the bank. We decided that we did not want to amend the treasurer report for July. You will see that there is an unusually high expense in this report for answering service expense and no expense for phone expense. The large payment to Townhall II now brings us up to date on what we owe. You will not see a charge for phone expense for a few meetings due to the high credit we have with MCI.

Included with this report you will find the Income/Expense Statement for the organization for the October 2020 meeting and one broken down by quarter for the last 12 months plus overall total during that period. You will also find a balance sheet, treasurer's worksheet, checkbook register and deposit total for the October 2020 meeting.


