Take a look, get inspired, grab another service enthusiast, and head out to let your community know that NA is here as a reliable and credible program.




And remember, we are all

Did you know? Many NA Regions worldwide have helplines that text you the five closest meetings based on zip code (43220 in the picture on the left). Each listing includes a map link, making it easy to get directions on your phone.

QR codes on billboards, fliers, palm cards, and newsletters can connect users directly to 24/7 virtual and phone meetings—so people can tap in during the drive to work, or going to an appointment, walking to a friend's house, etc.

Did you hear?

Incarcerated members across the US can access NA literature!

This is an amazing development.

Our H&I subcommittees have done wonders to get life saving, life changing NA literature into the hands of addicts behind the walls. They do an incredible job!

And now, many incarcerated members can also access NA resources straight from their prison-issued computer tablets.

When did this happen?

It stared about 7 years ago in Sarasota, FL at one county jail.

Then in 2021 PR subcommittees helped expand it to state prison systems in Ohio, Arizona, Indiana, and later in Connecticut.

In 2024 a slew of IPs, the audio book of the 5th edition of the Basic Text, and Reaching Out magazine (all in English and Spanish) were pushed out to over a million people.

How do they find it?

Take **Vigorous Steps** to inform incarcerated members and H&I committees that life-saving NA literature is available directly from their tablets if they have access Edovo or Cypherworx. Tell them search up NA!
