We've recently had only 5 groups represented at our monthly ASC meeting held at 565 Palmwood, the first Saturday of each month. Good morning Ohio Region, thank you for the opportunity to serve.

The Greater Cincinnati Area continues to focus on serving the fellowship through a stable network of 61 groups that host 82 meetings every week. During our March 15th meeting, we established quorum with 27 of our 35 voting groups in attendance. Financially, the area experienced a negative cash flow of \$619.39 for the February period. While our total income reached \$1,346.05—largely through \$880.90 in literature sales and \$465.15 in group donations—total expenses for the month were \$1,965.44. Major expenditures included significant literature purchases for the area and H&I, alongside travel reimbursements for RCM service. Despite this monthly deficit, the area maintains a healthy ending bank balance of \$4,539.23 as of February 28, 2026.

Our subcommittees remain highly active in their primary purpose. The Convention 2026 committee has officially selected "Secure in the love of the fellowship" as this year's theme and voted to move forward with the Holiday Inn & Suites Cincinnati–Eastgate as our host location. The convention fund currently holds a balance of \$11,382.04. The Hope Line committee has successfully updated their volunteer list to include 17 addicts and is actively seeking more members—specifically women—to reach their target of 25 to 30 volunteers. Additionally, the Hospitals &

Institutions committee has migrated to a new Zoom address and is preparing to bring a meeting to a member in the coming month.

In terms of area business, we passed two significant motions this month. Motion 2026-3 was approved to defer the upcoming April 11th event to the Activities and Abnormal Weenie Jam subcommittees for further review. We also passed Motion 2026-4 to remove "Friends of Jimmy K" from our website for housekeeping purposes. Finally, we are reaching out to the fellowship for nominations for several critical open service positions, including Area Vice-Treasurer, Hopeline Subcommittee Chairperson, and Literature Review Subcommittee Chair. We encourage any qualified members with the willingness to serve to step forward.

Most trusted servant positions are currently filled. Active subcommittees include Activities, H&I;, Outreach, PR, Literature/Merchandise, and Policy. H&I; continues service in treatment centers, jails, and correctional facilities. Public Relations remains active in schools and community agencies.

The Mid-East Area holds monthly Area Service Committee meetings and maintains a full service structure. Recent improvements include implementing an inventory tracking system and assigning responsibility for Area equipment management to the Activities Committee.

Challenges include inactive groups, communication gaps, and volunteer shortages for H&I; panels. Solutions include increased outreach efforts, improved accountability, inventory tracking, and exploring remote reporting options to encourage participation.

The Mid-East Area Summer Function is scheduled for July 18, 2026, at Lake Isabella. The shelter house by the volleyball court has been reserved, providing ample space for canopies, fellowship, and activities.

Phoneline Report

The lack of communication with Townhall has been concerning this quarter. We received invoices and reports regarding calls to our hopeline for January and February, but not for March.

It seems we are not alone in the lack of communication from Townhall. I read through some of the recent minutes posted on the Buckeye Region's website, and learned they have placed several unanswered calls to Townhall.
